Rightly Guided Caliphs - Hazrat Ali (ra)

His Holiness (aba) said that after Hazrat Uthman(ra) was martyred, Muslims flocked towards Hazrat Ali (ra), saying that Hazrat Ali(ra) was the next Caliph. Hazrat Ali(ra) responded by saying that the next Caliph would be he who the companions who participated in the Battle of Badr would choose as the next Caliph. Everyone insisted that the next Caliph should be Hazrat Ali (ra). Hazrat Ali(ra) inquired about Hazrat Sa'd(ra) and Hazrat Zubair (ra), upon which Hazrat Sa'd (ra) stepped forward and became the first to pledge allegiance at the hand of Hazrat Ali(ra). Afterwards, Hazrat Ali (ra) went to the mosque, where everyone pledged allegiance to him. His Holiness(aba) presented some quotations of Hazrat Musleh Mau'ud (ra) in which he stated that for Hazrat Ali(ra) to take up the mantle of the Caliphate at that time was a great sacrifice due to the difficult circumstances which had arisen, however, it was crucial that he did so, in order to keep the institution of the Caliphate firmly established.

7 STAGES OF SALAT BY HAZRAT MIRZA BASHIR UDDIN MEHMOOD AHMAD (RA)

- 1) The first stage, below which there is no stage whatsoever, is that man offers his five daily prayers regularly. A Muslim who offers his five daily prayers and does not break in between acquires the lowest level of faith.
- 2) The second stage in prayer is that all five prayers are offered at the stipulated time. When one offers his five daily prayers on time, he steps to the second ladder of faith.
- 3) The third stage is that the prayer is offered in congregation. By the congregational observance of prayer, a man steps to the third ladder of faith.
- 4) The fourth stage is that man observes the prayer whilst understanding its meaning. An individual, who does not know the translation of the prayer, should learn the translation and observe prayers. Moreover, one who does know the translation should offer the prayer slowly until he understands that he has done justice to the prayer.
- 5) Then, the fifth stage is that man becomes fully engrossed in the prayer. Just as one plunges into the water, a man should plunge into his prayer, until he acquires one of the two ranks: either that he is seeing God, or if not, he firmly believes that God the Exalted is seeing him.
- 6) After this, the sixth stage of belief is that an individual offers the Nawafil (Voluntary Prayers). One who offers the Nawafil expresses to God the Exalted, that he has offered his obligation, but he has not yet become satisfied by them, and he says, 'O God, it is my desire to remain in Your royal court beyond the times of obligation.'
- 7) The seventh stage of belief is that man not only offers his five daily prayers and observes the Nawafil, but also prays Tahajjud (Late night/pre-dawn prayer) during the night. These are the seven stages by which prayer is deemed complete.
