His Holiness^{aba} said that in accordance with this prophecy, Hazrat Mirza Bashiruddin Mahmud Ahmad^{ra} was born to the Promised Messiah^{as}, who would also go on to be chosen by God as the Second Caliph. He later also announced that in fact, he was the very son foretold by God to the Promised Messiah^{as}.

His Holiness^{aba} said that all the aspects of this prophecy were fulfilled in the person of Hazrat Mirza Bashiruddin Mahmud Ahmad^{ra}, and there are many non-Ahmadis who attest to this as well. His Holiness^{aba} said that he would mention some of his great academic achievements.

Huzoor aba said that including Tafsir-e-Kabir (the Grand Exegesis) and Tafsir-e-Saghir(the Short Commentary), the total number of pages spanning his work on the commentary of the Holy Qur'an is 28,735. He delivered 1,808 Friday Sermons, which span 18,700 pages. Huzoor aba said that in the Grand Exegesis, Hazrat Mirza Bashiruddin Mahmud Ahmad provided the commentary for 69 chapters.

THE PROMISED MESSIAHAS AND CONDITIONS OF FASTING

The Promised Messiah^{as} would tell individuals to open their fast if they were travelling. "When Allah has commanded to not fast whilst traveling, then one should not fast. Once there was very little time left till Iftar, it was after Asr time, the Promised Messiah^{as} told his guest to open his fast as he was travelling. He said just a little time is left. The Promised Messiah^{as} said you cannot make Allah happy by forcing Him to accept your Fasts rather you can make Allah happy with your obedience.

"Just as God has commanded to fast, He has also commanded to not fast under certain conditions. A person who fasts during Ramadan while he is sick or is travelling, is disobeying Allah and has to fast after becoming healthy or after completing one's journey. It is incumbent to follow this commandment of God. Salvation is based on Grace, not by force. God did not specify whether one has a minor ailment or large or whether the travelling distance is short or long."

'SATAN SHACKLED DURING THE MONTH OF RAMADAN'

EXPLAINED

"And when My servants ask thee about Me, say: "I am near. I answer the prayer of the supplicant when he prays to Me. So they should hearken to Me and believe in Me, that they may follow the right way." (The Holy Qur'an, 2:187)

Huzoor aba has stated that the above verse "is from among the verses stating the importance and obligation of Ramadan. Those being spoken of in this verse are those who are 'servants of the Gracious God' who wish to be freed from the clutches of Satan and come under the protection of God. Thus, God said that when such people are in a state of anxiety and fear wondering where and how they can find God, tell them that God will answer when they call unto Him. It is for such people that Satan has been shackled in Ramadan, but these efforts should not be limited to this month, rather they should become an

enduring part of people's lives throughout the year. When people fulfil the rights of God and His creation and strive to fulfil the commandments of God and attain His pleasure, then they will find that God answers their calls unto Him." Huzooraba further said that "The Promised Messiahas states, when we lessen our physical nourishment, it gives us the opportunity to increase in our spiritual nourishment. Otherwise, merely staying hungry for the entire day holds no meaning of its own if it is not accompanied by efforts to increase in spirituality."


